

Cookie Policy

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when you visit certain web pages. Cookies allow a web page to, among other things, store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or their computer and, depending on the information they contain and the way they use their equipment, they can be used to help the user recognizable anonymously.

Cookies are only associated with an anonymous user and their computer and contain no references that would allow the cookies to infer personal information.

In the case of registered users who register or have logged in, they can benefit from more personalized services aimed at their profile, thanks to the combination of the data stored in the cookies with the personal data used at the time of registration. These users expressly authorize the use of this information for the stated purpose, without prejudice to their right to refuse or disable the use of cookies.

Typology, purpose and functioning of cookies in general

Types of cookies according to the period they remain activated.

Depending on the length of time they remain activated in the terminal equipment, we can distinguish the following cookies:

1. Session cookies: These are cookies designed to collect and store data while the user is browsing a web page. They are usually used to store information that is only

interested in keeping for the provision of the service requested by the user on a one-off occasion (eg a list of products purchased). Persistent cookies: these are a type of cookies in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period of time determined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can be a few minutes up to several years.

2. Type of cookies according to the entity that manages them. Depending on the entity that manages the computer or domain from which the cookies are sent and treat the data obtained, we can distinguish
 1. Own cookies: these are cookies sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
 2. Third party cookies: these are cookies that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not controlled by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.
3. Types of cookies based on their purpose. Depending on the purpose for which the data obtained by cookies is processed, we can distinguish between:
 1. Technical cookies: are cookies that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform or application and use different options or services that exist in it, such as managing traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing sharing with limited access, remembering elements that make up an order, carrying out a purchase process of an order, making a request for registration or participation

in an event, using security elements during navigation, saving content for videos or sound broadcasting or sharing content through social networks.

2. Personalization cookies: these are cookies that allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics based on a series of criteria in the user's terminal, such as the language, the type of browser through which the user accesses the service, the regional configuration from where the user can access the service, etc.
3. Analysis cookies: these are cookies that allow the person responsible for the cookies to monitor and analyze the behavior of users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookie is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform and to create navigation profiles of the users of said sites, applications and platforms with the aim of making improvements resulting from the analysis of the usage data by the users of the service.

3. Consent and consent to the use of cookies

When you first access this website, you will see a space or banner informing you about the use of cookies and where you can view this cookie policy via a link. If you agree to the use of cookies and you continue to use the scroll bar to browse or scroll or click on a link (accept) as applicable, the user is deemed to have agreed to our cookie policy and thus the installation of cookies on his computer or device,

except in the case where the user has changed the configuration of his browser to refuse the use of cookies.

4. Note: “own” type cookies are only used by the owner of this website and “third party” cookies are also used by the service provider described in the previous table.

Browser configuration for revoking and withdrawing consent to the use of cookies.
